Official Entry Point

N GREENHILL AVENUE & W 4TH STREET

This entrance is for:

- Parade participants • Floats • Vehicles
- Follow cars • Parade units • Bars & organizations

PARADE CHECK-IN (REQUIRED)

Parade Check-In / Volunteer Check-In

W 4TH STREET & N BANCROFT PARKWAY

All parade participants must send one representative
to the official check-in tent.

Your representative will:

- Confirm your group's arrival
- Receive your lineup assignment
- Receive last-minute updates
- Receive any emergency information



OFFICIAL PARADE START

The parade officially begins at:

W 4TH STREET & N UNION STREET

Please remain in your assigned position
until the Parade Director gives the
signal to begin.



WALKER DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

Groups arriving without parade vehicles may be
dropped off at any of the following locations:

- W 3rd Street & N Bancroft Parkway
- W 4th Street & N Union Street
- W 5th Street & N Bancroft Parkway

After drop-off, proceed to your assigned lineup
location and have one representative check in.



ELECTED OFFICIALS & DIGNITARIES

Authorized Entrance Only

W 3RD STREET & N BANCROFT PARKWAY

MAIN STAGE & VENDOR AREA

Located at:

W 4TH STREET & N HARRISON STREET

Please keep this intersection clear unless
directed by parade staff.



EMS / FIRST AID

Located at:

W 4TH STREET & N VAN BUREN STREET

If you require medical assistance, notify the
nearest parade volunteer or police officer
immediately.



PARADE END POINT

The parade officially ends at:

N JACKSON STREET & W 4TH STREET



PARTICIPANT PICK-UP AREA

All participants should arrange to be picked up at:

W 3RD STREET & N JACKSON STREET

This is the official End Staging / Pick-Up Area
after the parade.
